The "American Woman" is a life-size marble sculpture that came from a 21 ton block of Colorado Yule (Valley Gold vein) marble. It took about 1600 hours in a time frame of a little over 2 years. The sculpture is of a woman in an evening gown reclining atop a 10' long concert grand piano. She and the piano are from the same block of marble. She is a composite of 6 models so she is unrecognizable yet the best of every woman. This is the first marble sculpture to have carved protruding eyelashes.

This sculpture has been to 17 cities and has traveled over 8 000 miles. Francisco signed over 17 000 marble chips and over 10 000 photos.

The American Woman has been on ABC, NBC, and CBS News over 30 times, a dozen radio interviews and over 100 newspaper and magazine articles. She has been filmed for a documentary, video and a DVD.

The American Woman has been and still is the talk of the town.
