


Our campaign includes exclusive behind-the-scenes video footage, interviews, portraits and heartwarming content shared on our social media platforms from November 2018 through June 2019.

The Jacques-Cartier Center has a residential component offering 27 social housing units to nearly 32 young people aged 17 to 32. Young people have access to activity organizers and social workers to guide them in their life plans. Every young person must take steps to find his life project and make it a reality.

The Center offers a multitude of training programs and workshops on various topics, of which nearly 200 young people, residents or not, benefit each year. Year in, year out, the Center reaches about 350 young people on a regular basis and 600 young people on a one-off basis.

We're proud to be giving our time and a yearly contribution of \$25,000 to the foundation. Our CEO, Patrick Perus, is also the President of the foundation, and one of our employees also sits on the Board of Directors.
