ELBERTON GRAY™ granite is a premium, fine-grained, blue-gray, and medium-grey stone quarried in Elberton, Georgia, known as the "Granite Capital of the World". Extracted from a vast underground deposit 35 miles long and 6 miles wide, with a depth of 2 to 3 miles, it is highly prized for its consistent texture, durability, and strength. Due to its high compressive strength and resistance to weathering, it is considered an ideal, long-lasting, and aesthetically pleasing building stone for curbing, paving, facades and landscaping.


